## Homes Association and Metropolitan District Respond to "Stay-at-Home" Public Health Order March 25, 2020

As you may already be aware, the Tri-County Health Department, whose jurisdiction includes our Village, today issued a "Stay-at-Home" Public Health Order, effective 8:00 am tomorrow, Thursday, March 26. ### Castle Pines Homes Association

The Homes Association staff, along with the dedicated men and women of Emergency Services, continue to provide safety, security and service to Village residents and their guests. Without laying off employees, we have reduced on-site staffing to limit employee exposure and help maintain a healthy workforce while continuing to provide essential services.

Here are the additional steps the Homes Association is taking to comply with the Order and protect our staff and residents:

**Recreational Facilities:** Pursuant to the Order, the Homes Association is closing the following recreational facilities effective 8:00 am tomorrow morning. Signs will be posted, and these facilities will remain closed until the Order expires or is lifted.

- Village Lake Fitness Center (already closed)
- Canyon Club tennis courts
- Canyon Club sports courts, including pickleball and basketball
- Canyon Club and Summit Club pavilion
- All pocket parks, playgrounds and play areas, including picnic areas and sports fields

Our trails will remain open and available for use, but you must comply with the "Social Distancing Requirements" described in the Order.

**Emergency Services:** Emergency Services will continue to operate our Dispatch Center and conduct patrols (including an on-duty EMT officer) 24 hours a day, seven days a week. RFID entry stickers will be available at Emergency Services, for new residents only, Monday through Friday, from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm.

As previously announced, Gates 1 and 4 will be staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and signs have been posted at Gates 2, 3 and 5 directing inbound visitor traffic to Gates 1 and 4. Exit lanes at all gates remain open and resident lanes at all gates remain open to residents with RFID stickers. If you are expecting a large delivery, please contact Emergency Services at 303.688.6446 to make appropriate arrangements.

If you experience a medical emergency or require medical assistance, please call Emergency Services or 911. Please inform the dispatcher if you are experiencing flu-like symptoms or are under quarantine for the COVID-19 virus so appropriate precautions can be taken to protect you and our first responders.

**Homes Association Office:** The Homes Association administrative offices will be closed at the end of business today, and our administrative personnel will begin working from home tomorrow. Notary services will not be available during the office closure. **Communication:** We will continue to use the Village Weekly and, if needed, our Reverse 911 telephone notification system to keep you informed of any additional changes to our operations. The Metro District building remains closed to public access. Staff can be reached by phone at 303.688.8330, Monday through Friday, from 8 am to 4:30 pm, or by email at [info@castlepinesmetro.com](mailto:info@castlepinesmetro.com). In case of emergency, please call Emergency Services at 303.688.6446, and Metro on-call staff will be contacted. The Metro District staff remains ready to plow Village streets in case of a spring snowstorm, and the pandemic has had no impact on their ability to provide safe drinking water.
